Competition Requirements:

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements, General Livestock Competition Requirements, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market Competitions shall provide a premises identification number at the time of entry.
3. **BEDDING:** Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition does not include bedding. Bedding may be pre-purchased at the time of entry. Pre-purchased bedding may be picked up in the designated area on load-in days. Exhibitors must be present to claim their pre-purchased bedding. Refunds will not be issued for any pre-purchased bedding.

Straw may only be used for Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Breeding Sheep and Cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

4. Copies of registration papers must be submitted at the time of entry. Original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show.
5. The World Watusi Association offers 20% of the total premiums including champion classes and Halter Futurity. The Colorado State Fair will pay 80% of the premiums including champion classes & Halter Futurity. Premium checks will be paid directly from the Colorado State Fair. (See W.W.A. Futurity Section Competition Requirements for special Futurity premiums).
6. All animals born before January 1, of the current year, must be registered in the name of the exhibitor in the Herdbook of an Ankole-Watusi registry to be eligible to show. Registration papers must be available to Association Representative upon arrival.
7. All animals shown must be 50% or more Ankole-Watusi blood, match the individual registration paper and be shown in their respective class divisions.
8. **When entering animals in the Cow/Calf classes, only enter the Cow. This will eliminate duplicate entries and overpayment of entry fees.**
9. At least four (4) animals must be shown in each division in order for a Division Champion and Reserve Champion to be awarded.
10. Classes will be shown in the class order listed.

11. Cattle will be received through Livestock Gate #4 (off of Mesa Ave) and will be housed in the Livestock Barn pens and tie-rails. Holding pens are reserved for pen entries only.
12. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

World Watusi Association Pen Futurity Special Rules

1. Animals nominated and shown in the W.W.A. Futurity (classes 1104 thru 1107) must be registered in the Herdbook of the World Watusi Association and be regularly entered in their respective Colorado State Fair class.
2. Nominations, including all nomination fees and late penalty fees (if any) must be submitted directly to the World Watusi Association before the show. The nomination fee is \$50.00 per animal. Premiums will be awarded depending on the number of animals in each class.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR - Exhibitor is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or co-ownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor". An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less. In the event of tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc. The same point system as Premier Breeder will be used in all Breeds, unless otherwise stated under individual breed:

1st Place – 5 points
 2nd Place – 4 points
 3rd Place – 3 points
 4th Place – 2 points
 5th Place – 1 point

Champion – 7 points
 Res. Champion – 6 points
 Grand Champion – 10 points
 Res. Grand Champion – 8 points

PREMIER SIRE – An award will be given to the sire with the most progeny exhibiting at the Colorado State Fair. This award will be tabulated from the registration information provided on the entry forms.
