## WHAT'S IN 2021

ALL livestock entries must be submitted **ONLINE**. Entries sent via mail will not be accepted.

Small Animal entries must be postmarked on or before August 2, 2021. Poultry entries cannot be done online.

Due to the continuation of positive cases of RHDV2 within the State of Colorado, there will BE NO MARKET, JUNIOR OR OPEN RABBIT shows at the 2021 Colorado State Fair.

DNA will be required on all MARKET HOGS nominated and entered in the Colorado State Fair.

All other species (Market Beef, Market Goats and Market Lambs) that do not have retinal scans attached to the nomination form will need to submit DNA within the time limits.

The Market Show schedule has been changed from past years. Exhibitors are required to be familiar with the schedule and when the species they show **MUST** be on grounds. Due to barn space, the CSF Management asks that exhibitors not come in early unless they are showing more than one species.

Market Goats will show on Monday, August 30, 2021. Showmanship will be at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup>.

The Colorado State Fair will be sponsoring a COLORADO MASTER SHOWMANSHIP class in 2021. This class will be open to the top placing exhibitor at each County Fair Round Robin in 2021. This show will be on Saturday, September 4<sup>th</sup>.

There will be NO Dual Coated, Natural Colored or White Handspinning classes offered in the Open Breeding Sheep show.

Open and Junior Miniature Hereford Show. Cattle will arrive on Wednesday, September 1, 2021 and the shows will be held on Thursday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>. This will be the Finals of the "Cattle Battle Series."

Poultry exhibitors will be required to provide feed for their birds and will be responsible for the feed and watering of their birds/rabbits. Market, Junior and Open Poultry Exhibitors are responsible for leaving enough food for all birds left in the barn to be sold. The Colorado State Fair **WILL NOT** be purchasing feed for birds in the Small Animal barn.
