RULES OF COMPETITION

1. Entry is by invitation only. Trucks are approved to participate in the contest when a contract, insurance, Colorado Proud registration (www.coloradoproud.org) and proof of health permit is submitted to the Commercial Exhibits Department.
2. Competition will take place near the PB&T Bank Pavilion. Cooking must take place inside of a fully self-contained truck. No electricity, water, or grease disposal will be provided.
3. Trucks must prepare one sample sized item for 500 guests with the following theme:
 - a. FAIR FOOD – Choose an item that represents your take on a favorite Fair Food. Item must feature a Colorado sourced ingredient and your Colorado ingredient(s) and their producers (farm, ranch, or local source) must be shared with fair and will be shared with judges.
4. The fair reserves the right to increase the number of servings to be provided by 5 p.m. August 10th, 2022.
5. Trucks must display the name of the served item only, no other menu items should be visible.
6. Trucks must display a jar (provided by fair) for the purpose of People's Choice voting.
7. Trucks will coordinate with State Fair staff to help facilitate a private tasting for the Governor upon his arrival.
8. Each truck will be paid a stipend of \$1,800.00 for the event. An additional travel stipend is available for attendees traveling over 100 miles from event location.

JUDGING CRITERIA & AWARDS

The Governor will select an overall winner to be awarded the Governor's Plate. People's Choice will be selected by guest attendees. The jar with the most tickets at 6:30 p.m. will win.
