(Receiving, judging, and release will be located at the west end of the Colorado Agriculture Pavilion.)

Entry form and fee deadline - Wednesday, July 19, 2023, by 4:00 p.m.

Receiving - Thursday, August 24, 2023, in place by 6:00 p.m.

Judging - Sunday, August 27, 2023, 10:00 a.m.

Release - Monday, September 4, 2023, before 10:00 a.m.

Entry Requirements (these requirements are **in addition** to the *2023 Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements* as well as the *General Entry/Fine Arts 2023 Competition & Entry Requirements*)

1. An entry consists of one or more items entered by one exhibitor in a single class to be judged together. Example: In class 20, an individual entry may consist of multiple panels and gates entered by one exhibitor. The set will be judged as one entry and subject to a single entry fee.
2. Judges will base placing on evidence of sound planning, number and degree of skills involved, practicality of the entry, and quality of workmanship. Judges reserve the right to move entries to a different class if it is a better fit there.
3. In the FFA group, only Colorado FFA members whose work and records are completed to date and who are certified by their teacher of Vocational Agriculture are eligible to exhibit. No entries will be accepted unless properly certified. Entries must be primarily constructed by the FFA member.
4. Exhibitors, please enter through Gate #8.
5. All articles entered for exhibition must be placed prior to 6:00 p.m., Thursday, August 24th.

Classes

0001. Cabinets and box type projects, constructed of wood

Home improvement or family living projects made of metal or wood

0002. Large

0003. Small

Equipment, made primarily of metal, for use in home farm shop

0004. Large

0005. Small

0006. Shop tools

0007. Light feeding equipment made of wood or metal

0008. All other wood structures used on the farm

(showing a variety of farm woodworking skills)

0009. Heavy feeding equipment made of wood or metal

0010. Practical farm equipment used in productive livestock and crop enterprises, not power-driven, combination wood and metal

0011. Equipment, utilizing electrical power to conserve labor or improve efficiency in the home farm shop

0012. Livestock trailers

0013. Other trailers and wagons, including machinery transporting equipment *Farm equipment, primarily metal, power-driven to conserve labor and increase farming efficiency (not shop equipment)*

0014. Power take off and hydraulic

0015. Self-powered

Practical farm equipment, primarily metal, used in crop production (not power-driven)

0016. Large

0017. Small

Practical farm equipment, primarily metal, used in livestock production (not power-driven)

0018. Large

0019. Small

0020. Metal panels and gate

0021. Farm Vehicle Accessories (bumpers, tailgates, etc.)

0022. Remanufactured and/or repaired equipment or projects
