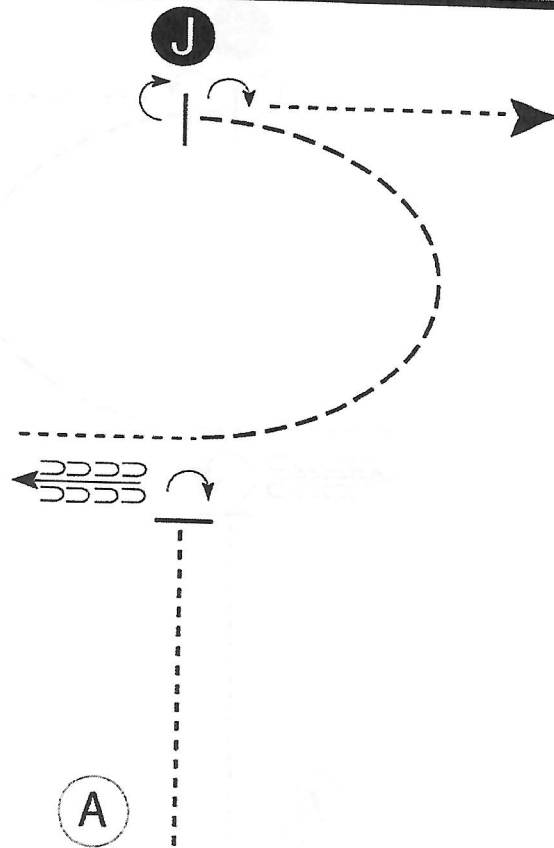

2. Stop and perform a 1/4 turn.
3. Back approximately one horse length.
4. Walk until even with Judge.
5. Trot in a half circle until even with Judge.
6. Perform a 1/4 turn, stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 1/4 turn and walk straight away from Judge.

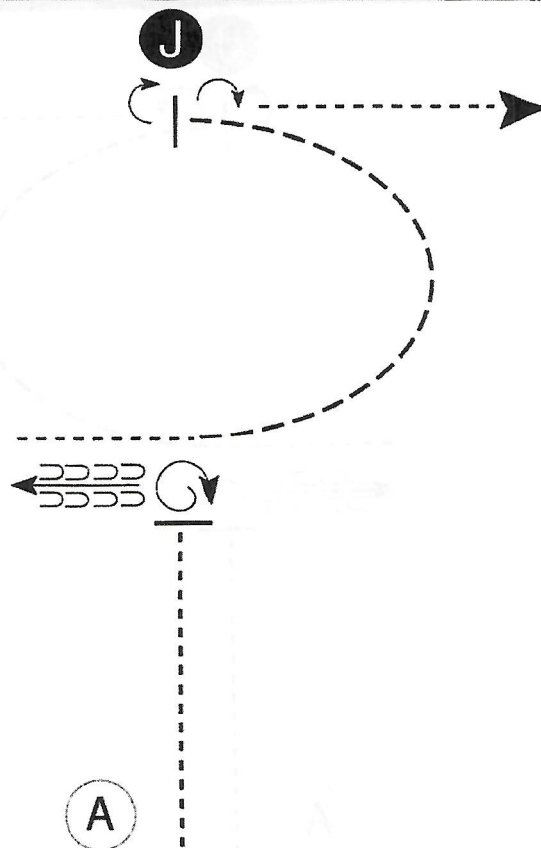

6. Perform a 1/4 turn, stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 1/4 turn and walk straight away from Judge.

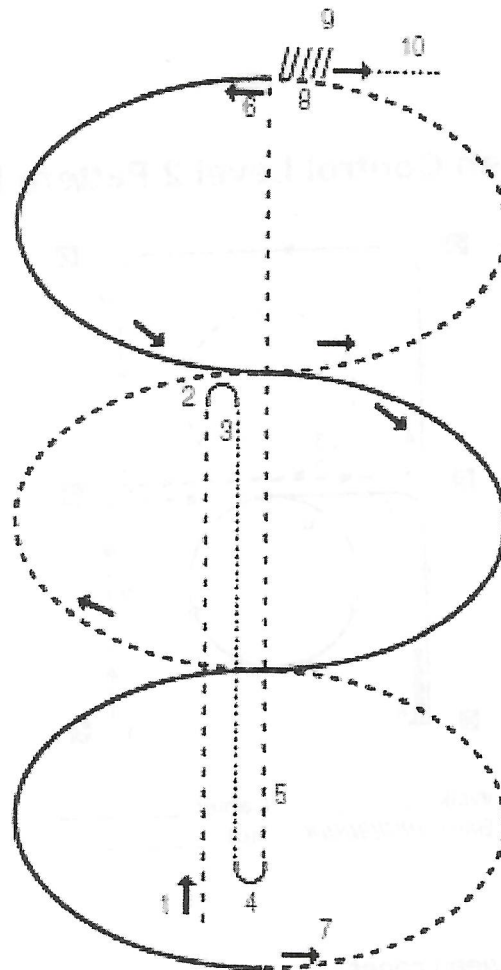


Walk: Canter: _____
 Back: ////////////// Trot: - - - - -

1. Normal walk
2. Rising trot halfway between cones
3. Change diagonal then circle right, rising trot
4. Canter right lead
5. Sitting trot
6. Canter left lead, circle left
7. Continue canter left lead
8. Halt and back one horse length

Leave the arena on a loose rein at the free walk.

480. Pattern 2 – Level III and IV English Control

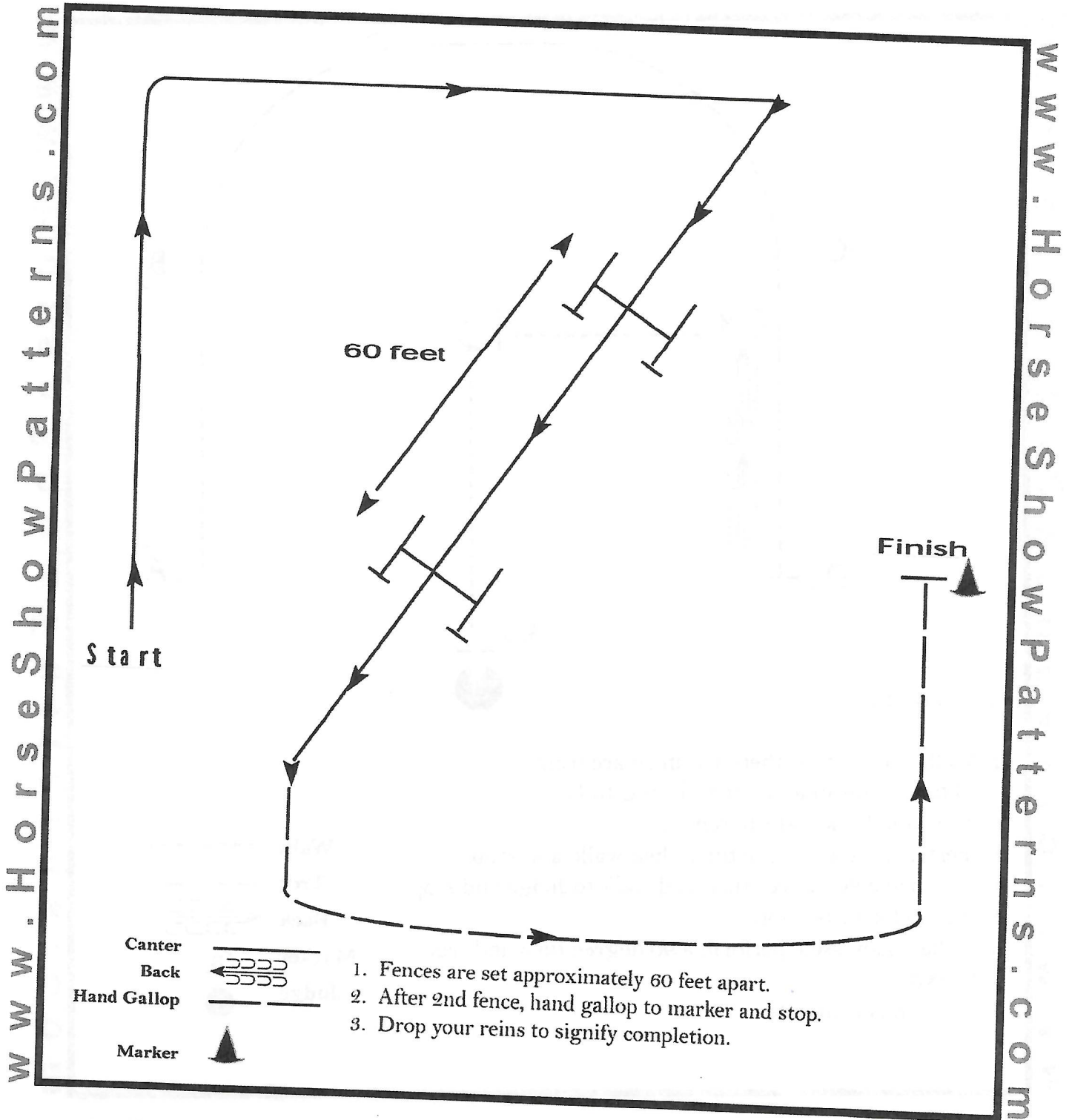


Walk: Canter: _____
 Back: //////////////// Trot: - - - - -

1. Sitting trot.
2. Halt, half turn (180 degrees) right on haunches.
3. Normal walk.
4. Halt, half turn (180 degrees) left on haunches.
5. Lengthen trot rising.
6. Canter serpentine with appropriate changes of lead, simple or flying.
7. Rising trot serpentine with change of diagonals.
8. Halt.
9. Back.
10. Leave arena on a loose rein at the free walk.

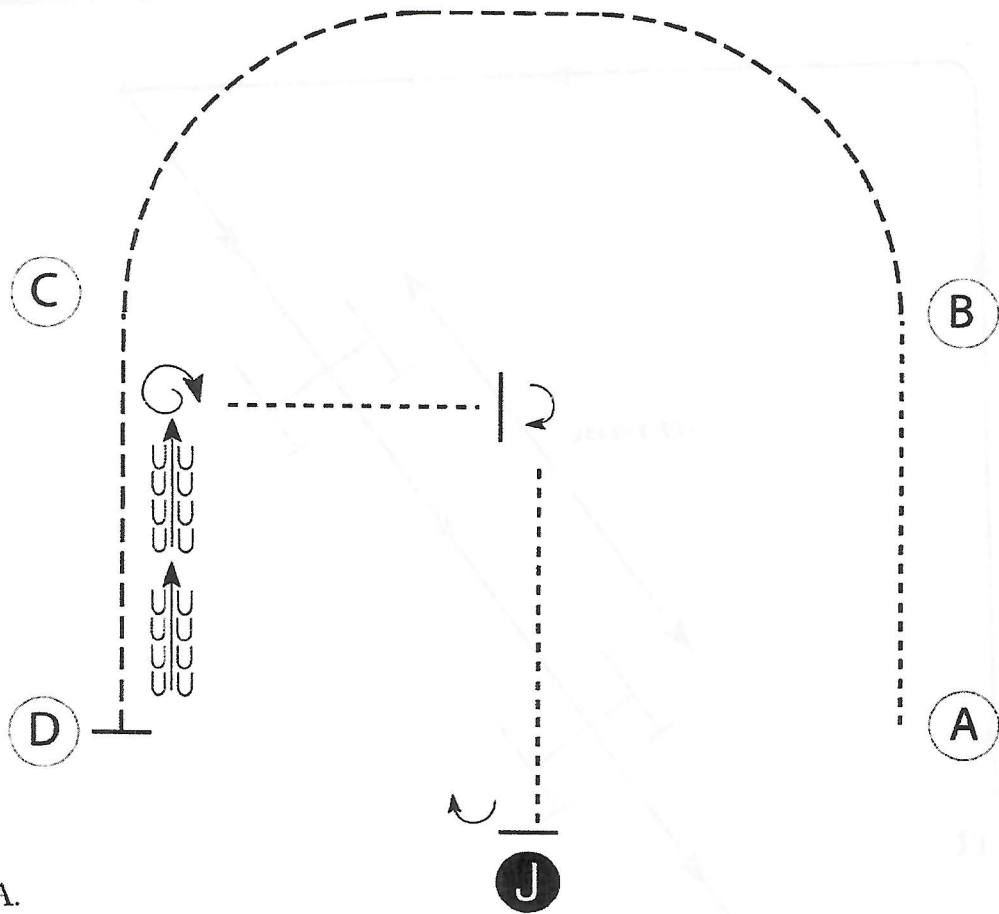

Be ready at A.

1. Walk from A to B then trot in an arc from B to C. Continue the trot from C to D.
2. Stop and back eight to ten feet.
3. Perform a 270 degree turn, then walk, and stop.
4. Perform a 90 degree turn and walk to Judge and stop.
5. Set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn and trot to exit.
7. Pattern is complete.

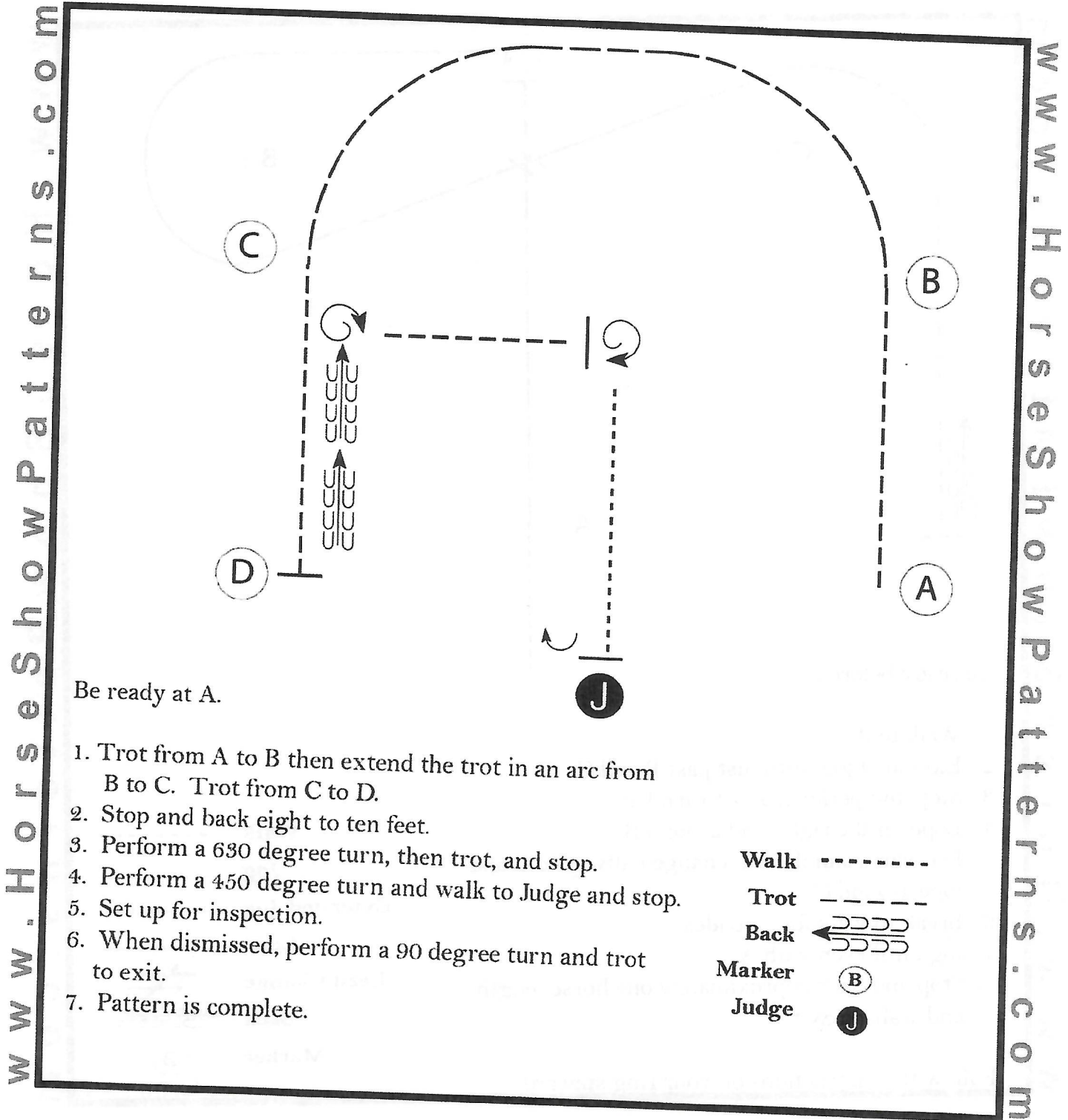

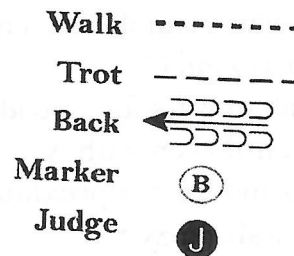

Western Showmanship (Levels III & IV All Ages)



Be ready at A.

1. Trot from A to B then extend the trot in an arc from B to C. Trot from C to D.
2. Stop and back eight to ten feet.
3. Perform a 630 degree turn, then trot, and stop.
4. Perform a 450 degree turn and walk to Judge and stop.
5. Set up for inspection.
6. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn and trot to exit.
7. Pattern is complete.

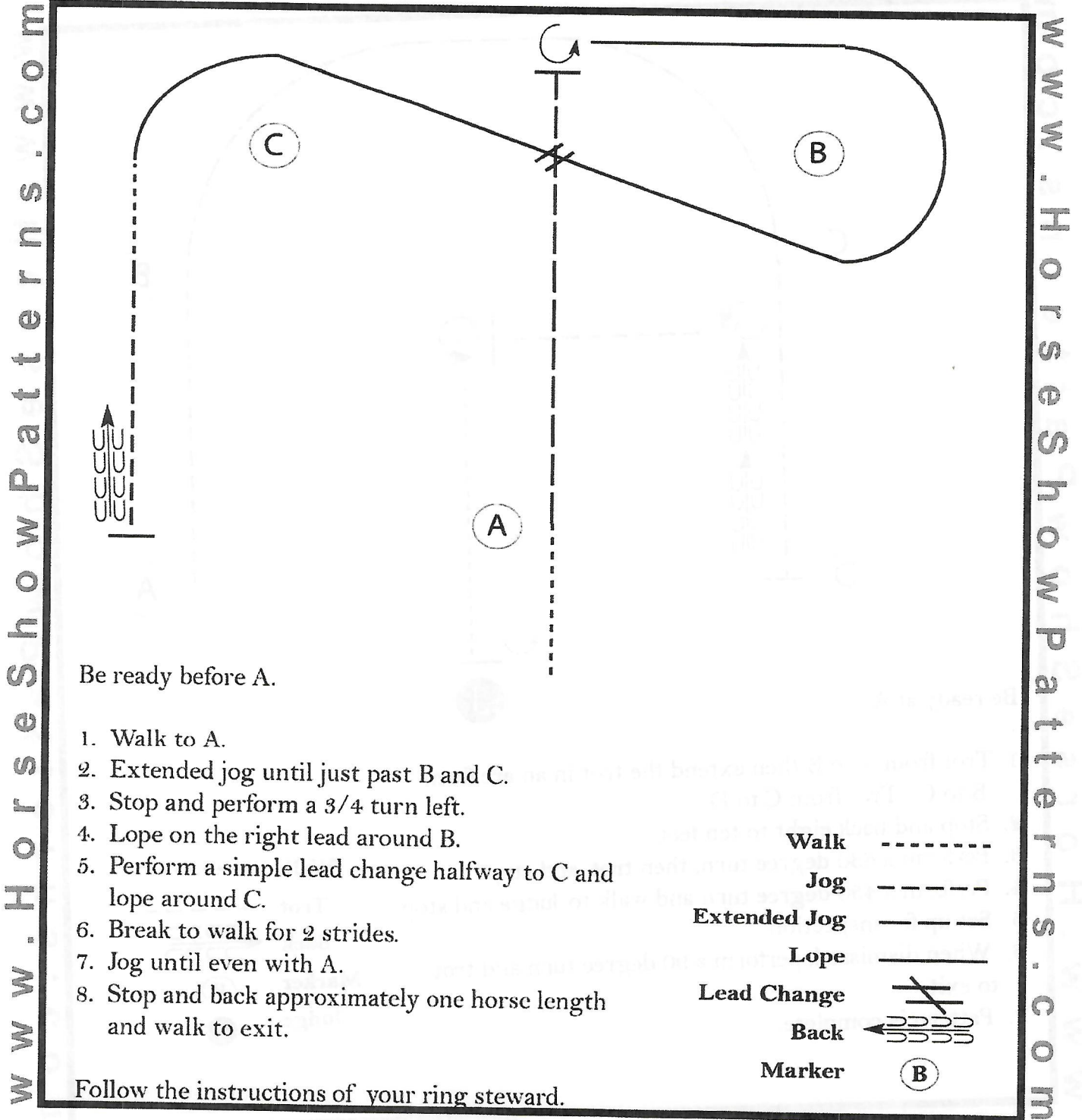

172. Pattern I - Level II

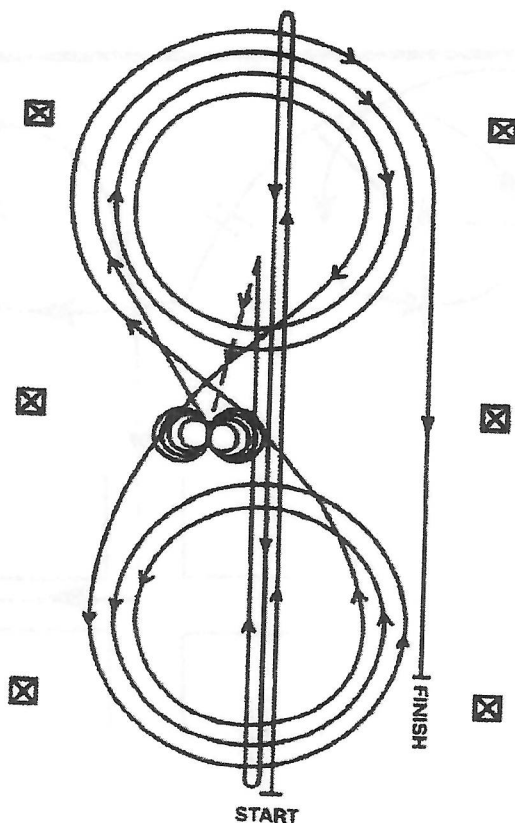


Back:  Jog:  Lope: 

Proper execution of this pattern requires Level II advancement skills. All stops are balanced.

1. Start at end of arena. Run down middle past center marker to a balanced stop.
2. Back at least ten feet to center. 90 degree turn to the left.
3. Pickup right lead, large fast circle, small slow circle.
4. Simple lead change to left, large fast circle, small slow circle.
5. Simple lead change to right, do not close this circle.
6. Run around end of arena and down the side (approximately 20 feet from fence) past center marker and come to a balanced stop.
7. Turn 180 degrees on the haunches to the left.
8. Continue back down side and end of arena to other side (approximately 20 feet from fence) go past center marker and come to a balanced stop.
9. Turn 180 degrees on the haunches to the right. Hesitate to complete pattern.

Reining Level III & IV Pattern 5 (NRHA Pattern 7)



1. Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right; the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the left; the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large fast circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstration completion of the pattern.

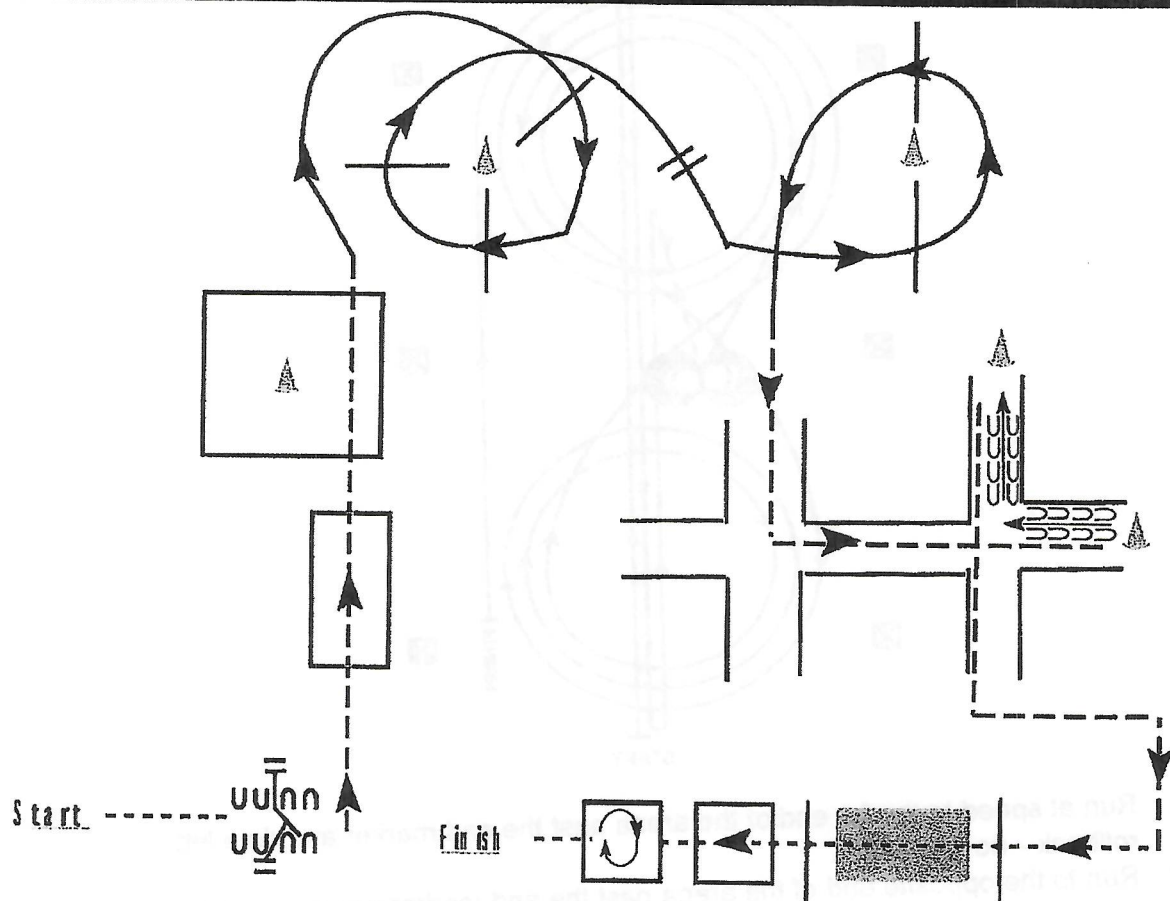

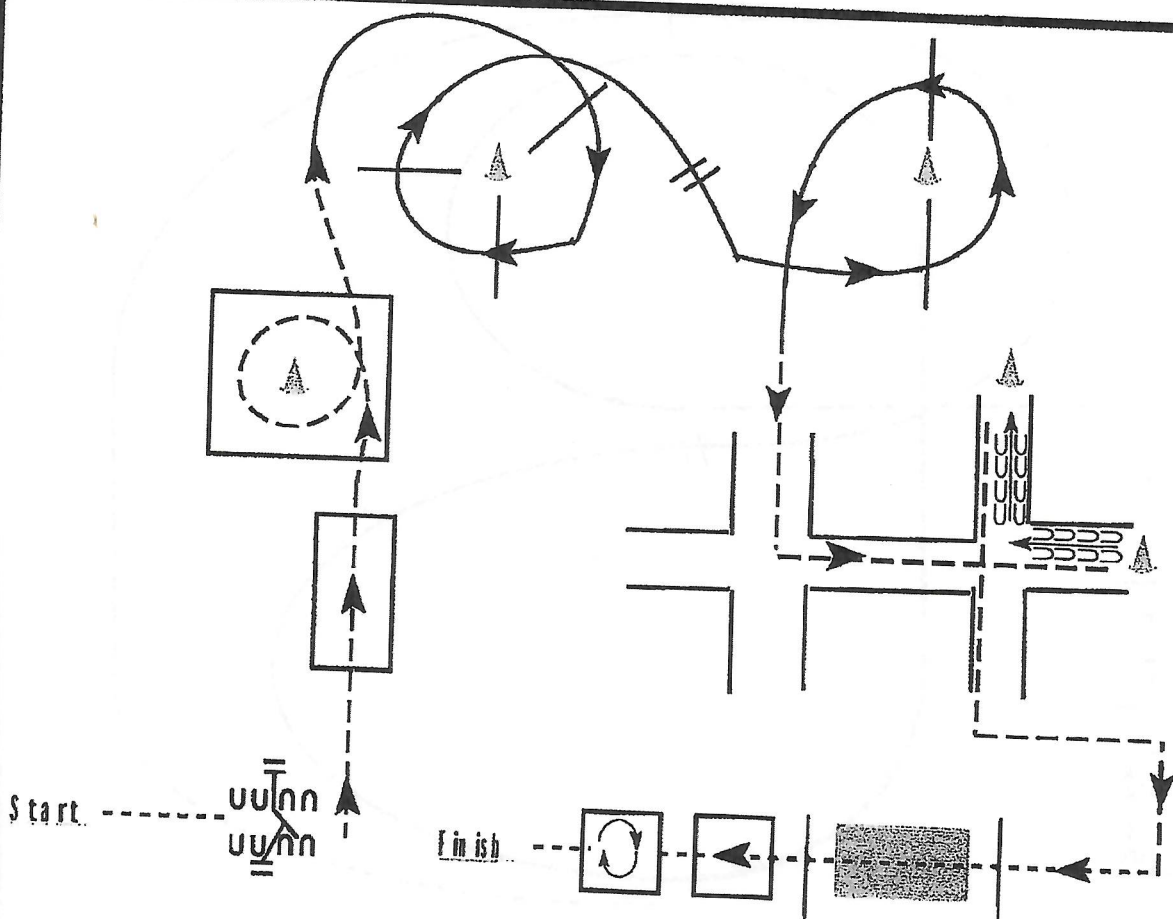

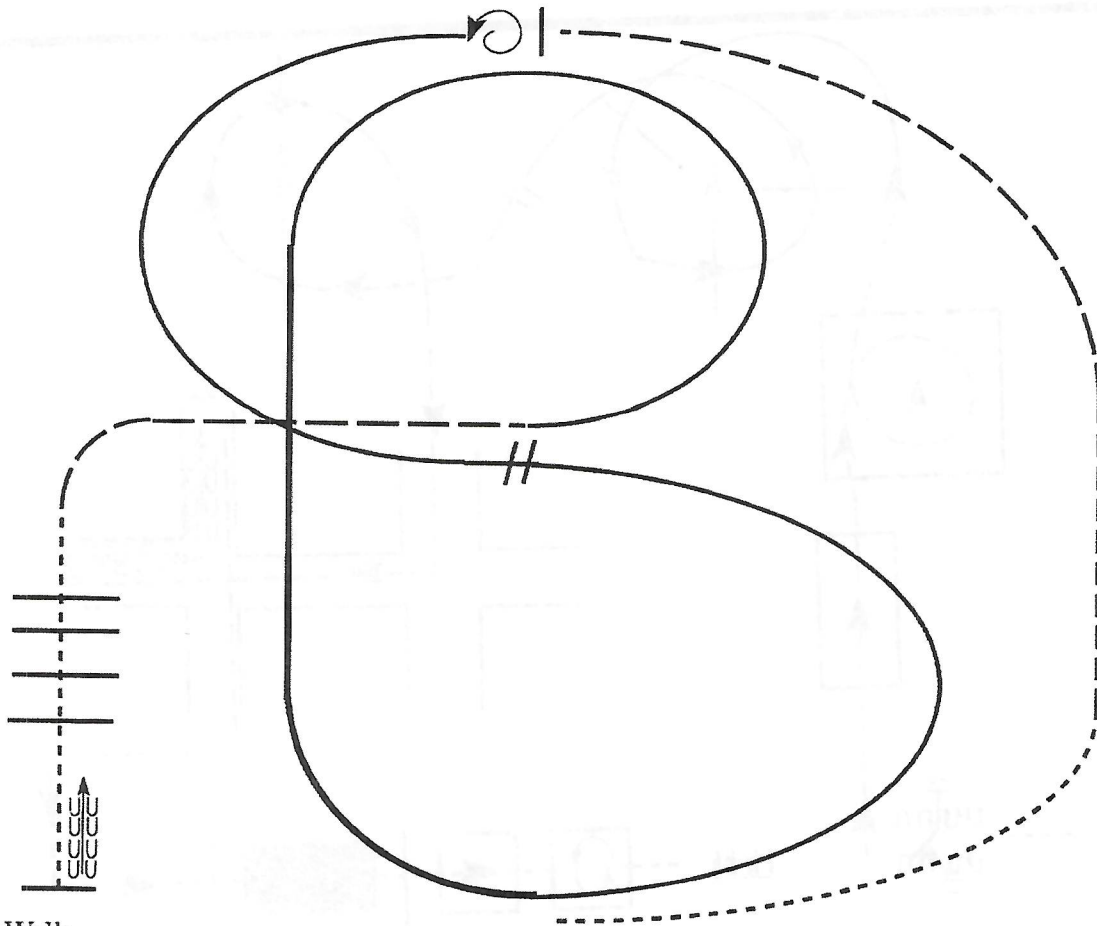

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena, stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead 1/2 circle, lope to the center
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead 1/2 circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
10. Break down to an extended trot
11. Walk over poles.
12. Stop and back

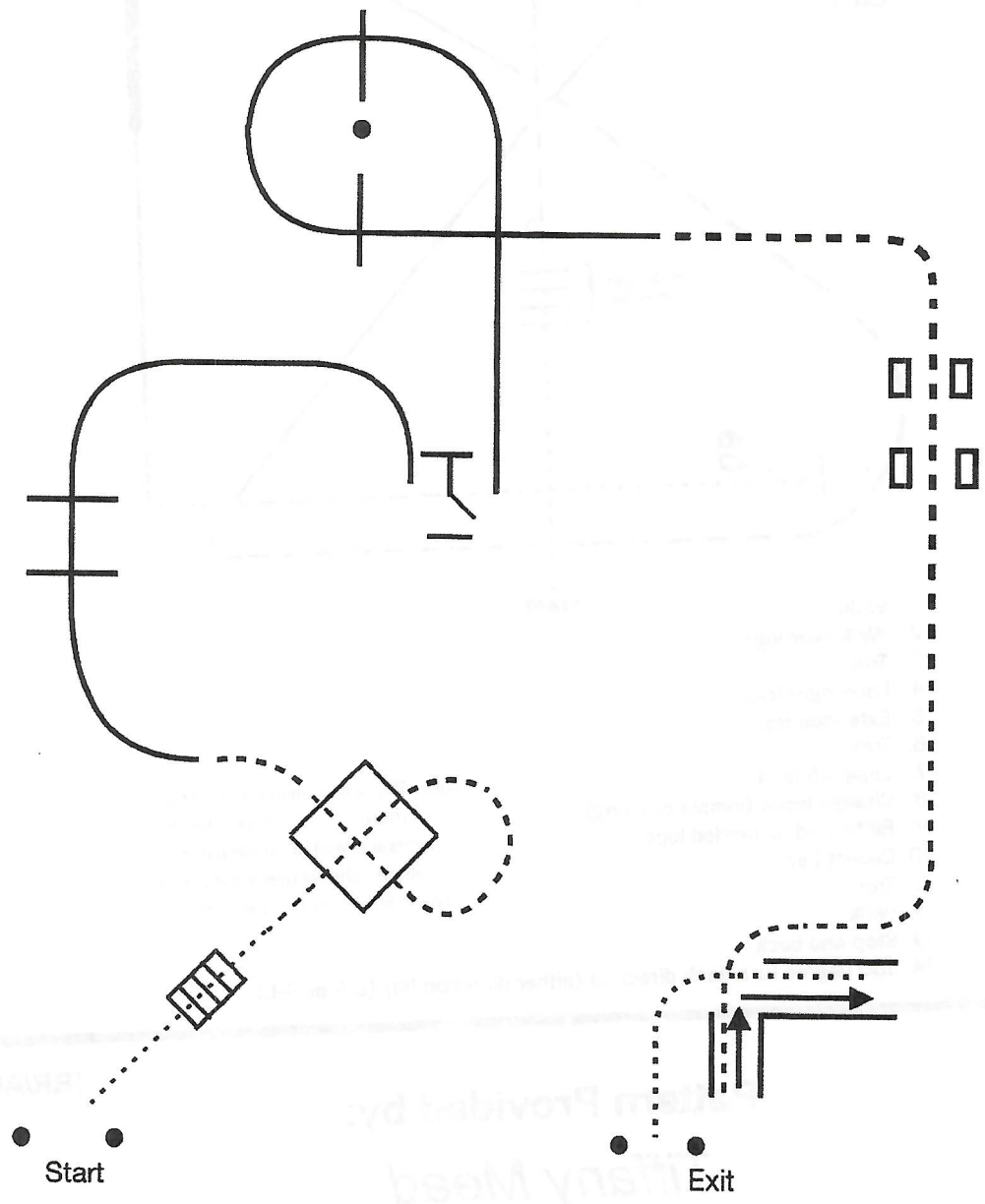

 9. Trot into Chute and Back "L"
