### Competition Requirements::

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements, General Livestock Competition Requirements, Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct, Animal Welfare Policy, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market Competitions shall provide a Premises Identification (PID) number at the time of entry. To obtain a PID, contact the Colorado Department of Agriculture at 303-869-9130 or [www.coloradodepartmentofagriculture/animals\\_ag.colorado.gov](http://www.coloradodepartmentofagriculture/animals_ag.colorado.gov).
3. **BEDDING:** Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the ("CSF") does not include bedding. Bedding may be pre-purchased at the time of entry. Pre-purchased bedding may be picked up in the designated area on load-in days. Exhibitors must be present to claim their pre-purchased bedding. Refunds will not be issued for any pre-purchased bedding.

Straw may only be used for Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Breeding Sheep and Open Breeding Cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

**Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.**

4. Original registration papers or ownership certificates must be available for inspection at the show. To be eligible to show, all sheep must be registered in their respective breed associations and bear the proper breed association ear tags where applicable.

5. This division will be divided into two (2) categories based on foundation or origin of color in the sheep and two (2) categories in White Handspinning Sheep.
6. Category I Long Wools/Carpet: Wool grading 48's and coarser, sheep that are descendants of Lincoln, Romney, Border Leicester Jacob, Karakul, Navajo and Churro.
7. Category II Medium and Fine Wool: All sheep descendants of dual-purpose meat breeds, i.e., Corriedale, Columbia, Rambouillet, Hampshire or any other breed with wool grading 50's or finer.
8. Animal Preparation: for Category I sheep, wool length is expected to be two (2) inches or longer, except in young lambs. Sheep may be trimmed, tipped, or fuzzed-off, but not blocked. Bellies, heads, lower legs, and dock area may have wool of any length preferred by Exhibitor, but wool must not be trimmed or blocked to unequal lengths on chest, back, shoulder, sides, or britch area. Wool must be free of excessive contamination, manure, paint, permanent stains, wool rot, breaks or tenderness, and cotting. These problems will be penalized according to their severity. Category II sheep (which includes Fine and Medium breeds) may be fitted to breeder preference while maintaining the quality of the fleece to be evaluated.
9. All sheep will be judged 40% on conformation and 60% on wool. All Natural Colored sheep must be 35% colored.
10. All sheep must be shorn after August 1, 2024.
11. ENTRY NUMBERS: Each entry will be assigned a number. Entry numbers will be provided to all exhibitors. These numbers must be displayed by the exhibitor when the animal is in the show ring.
12. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one class. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.
13. Ribbons and premiums will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> through 6th place in all individual classes.

**PREMIER EXHIBITOR:** An award will be given in each breed of the Open Breeding Sheep section to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less, owned and exhibited by him/herself in individual classes. Group classes are not considered. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the exhibitor: (1) Earning points in the greatest number of classes; (2) Winning the most first places; (3) Winning the most second places, etc.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> place .....	5 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place.....	4 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> place.....	3 points

4 <sup>th</sup> place.....	2 points
5 <sup>th</sup> place.....	1 point
Champion.....	8 points
Res Champion.....	6 points
