# LIMITED TO FOUR (4) MARKET BEEF PER EXHIBITOR

**Competition Requirements:** (subject to change without notice)

- 1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements, General Livestock Competition Requirements, Junior Livestock Competition Requirements, Junior Livestock Sale Participation Requirements, 2024 Animal Welfare Policy, and Health Requirements. Exhibitors must comply with the Wholesome Meat provisions and the Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct. Exhibitors are encouraged to read and be fully informed of the contents of the Drug Residue Avoidance Guidelines.
- 2. All exhibitors in Open, Junior Breeding and Market shows must submit a premises identification (PID) number at entry. PID may be obtained by calling 303-869-9130 or online at <a href="https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/colorado-location-identification-lid-registration-premises">https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/colorado-location-identification-lid-registration-premises</a>.
- 3. Bedding: Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition ("CSF") does not include bedding.

Straw may only be used for dairy cattle, dairy goats, breeding sheep, and open breeding cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Exhibitors may pre-order bedding and shavings through Rustic Ranch supply or bedding and shavings will be available to purchase on-grounds from Rustic Ranch Supply upon arrival. The telephone number and order portal will be posted on the Fair's website.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

- 4. Market Beef Classes are open to steers and heifers. Steers and heifers must weigh a minimum of 1,050 pounds to be eligible to compete in the market classes.
- 5. All heifers must be accompanied by a certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian verifying the heifer is pregnancy tested OPEN within 30 days of the CSF.
- 6. Steers and heifers will be shown by weight. Steers and heifers will be divided by sex into classes as determined appropriate by the CSF Superintendents. Heifers will compete in a heifer class. All steers placing first in a class will compete in the Grand Champion Drive. Second place class winner from the class from which the Grand Champion Market Beef is selected may be considered for Reserve Grand Champion Market Beef. Heifers will compete equally with the steers in the Grand Champion Drive.
- 7. **Entry Numbers**: Each entry will be assigned a number. Entry numbers will be provided to exhibitors. These numbers must be displayed by the exhibitor when the animal is in the show ring.
- 8. There will be no official weigh-in of Market Beef. Scales will be available for the exhibitors' use until the deadline for turning in the weight nomination form. An official weight nomination form must be obtained by the exhibitor when the animal is inspected. The official weight nomination form must be turned into the Livestock Office no later than the deadline listed above. The weight(s) indicated on the weight nomination form will be the official show weight. There will be no changing of weights after the weight nomination form has been turned in.
- 9. A water container, with water, must be visible and available for watering on a regular basis in each penned/stalled area at all times. NO feeding or watering of livestock in show rings, holding pens or to and from re-weigh stations will be permitted. CSF officials reserve the right, at its discretion, to contact an Authority veterinarian to determine if water should be given.
  Drenching for hydration purposes will be allowed. No stomach pumping will be permitted.
- 10. Nose rings or tongs may be used by market beef exhibitors for the control of their animal.
- 11. Exhibitors only are allowed in the beef show ring staging areas.
- 12. After each class of Market Beef has been placed, the top five animals will be weighed on the official scale by show officials. Market Beef cannot deviate more than 5% above or below the declared show weight as previously designated by the exhibitor on the weight card. If any Market Beef is weighed out, it will be disqualified, and the remaining animals will be moved up in placing. The disqualified beef is not eligible for any other class and will not be reweighed.
- 13. Any violation of the General Livestock Competition Requirements and Junior Livestock Competition Requirements regarding fitting of livestock may result in disciplinary action. NO AEROSOLS IN THE SHOW ARENA OR HOLDING PENS

- 14. Once the sale beef have been determined, those animals will be moved to a showcase area designated by the Livestock Superintendents. All equipment, except for those items needed to feed and water animals and clean stalls, shall be removed from the barn. The Authority will provide each exhibitor with two (2) bags of shavings for use in the new stalling area.
- 15. This show is a terminal show **only** for the Junior Market Beef that are selected for the Junior Livestock Sale. There is no buy-back consignment offered through the Authority. Market Beef that does not make the sale will be released to the exhibitor after the final sale order is posted. Market Beef exhibitors are encouraged to utilize sound biosecurity practices upon departure from the fairgrounds; recommended biosecurity procedures are available in the Livestock Office.

- 6. Rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place in each division. No premiums will be paid for Showmanship.
