## Competition Requirements:

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Terms and Conditions, General Livestock Competition Requirements, Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct, Animal Welfare Policy, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
2. All exhibitors in Open, Junior Breeding and Market shows must submit a premises identification (PID) number at entry. PID may be obtained by calling 303-869-9130 or online at https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/colorado-location-identification-lid-registration-premises.
3. Bedding: Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition ("CSF") does not include bedding.

Straw may only be used for dairy cattle, dairy goats, breeding sheep, and open breeding cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Exhibitors may pre-order bedding and shavings through Rustic Ranch supply or bedding and shavings will be available to purchase on-grounds from Rustic Ranch Supply upon arrival. The telephone number and order portal will be posted on the Fair's website.

## Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

4. Original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show.
5. All animals entered in this combined Hereford/Polled Hereford show must be registered with the American Hereford Association or the American Polled Hereford Association to be eligible to show. Animals must be entered and shown under the recorded owner's name.
6. Any animal without a legible tattoo matching the registration papers will be ineligible to show.
7. Exhibitors in these breeding cattle classes are subject to their association's special rules on class qualification, defects and unethical practices. All animals at all AHA sponsored shows must be officially recorded at show time to be eligible to show. An official AHA registry number at entry time will be required.
8. All Hereford entries must be duly recorded with the American Hereford Association. Any animal with a "pending" or "applied for" registration or without a legible tattoo will not be eligible for show competition. All entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the American Hereford Association Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the Show and Sale Committee representing the AHA.
9. Scurs on polled Herefords should be left as is and should not be tampered with or removed.
10. ENTRY NUMBERS: Each entry will be assigned a number. Entry numbers will be provided to all exhibitors. These numbers must be displayed by the exhibitor when the animal is in the show ring.
11. Authority officials have the right to combine any class with 5 or less animals.
12. Calf entries from Cow/Calf cannot be older than 270 days on show date. Calf is eligible for individual classes but must be entered in appropriate class. Cow/calf does not compete for overall champion female.
13. In the Cow/Calf class, if the cow is horned and the calf polled, then the pair will show in the horned Cow/Calf class, and if the cow is polled and the calf is horned, then the pair will show in the polled Cow/Calf class.
14. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR - "Exhibitor" is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or coownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor." An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less. In the event of tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes excluding champion classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc.

Points will be awarded as follows, unless otherwise stated under individual breed:
