Competition Requirements:

- 1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the Colorado State Fair General Terms and Conditions Requirements, General Livestock Competition Requirements, Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct, Animal Welfare Policy, and Health Requirements. When applicable all association rules shall apply.
- 2. All exhibitors in Open, Junior Breeding and Market shows must submit a premises identification (PID) number at entry. PID may be obtained by calling 303-869-9130 or online at https://ag.colorado.gov/animals/colorado-location-identification-lid-registration-premises.
- 3. Bedding: Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition ("CSF") does not include bedding.

Straw may only be used for dairy cattle, dairy goats, breeding sheep, and open breeding cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Exhibitors may pre-order bedding and shavings through Rustic Ranch supply or bedding and shavings will be available to purchase on-grounds from Rustic Ranch Supply upon arrival. The telephone number and order portal will be posted on the Fair's website.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

- 4. Original papers must be available for inspection at the show.
- 5. Registered cattle, not previously designated in a specific sanctioned breed classification, are eligible to participate. **Crossbred Cattle do not qualify in open classes.**

- 6. Exhibitors shall follow specific Breeds' Associations Rules, Regulations, and Policies.
- 7. Cattle shall meet conformation characteristics, as set forth by each Association's standards. Exhibitors in these breeding cattle classes are subject to their Association's special rules on class qualification, defects and unethical practices.
- 8. Association representatives may check tattoos to confirm they match the original certificate and entry form.
- 9. ENTRY NUMBERS: Each entry will be assigned a number. Entry numbers will be provided to all exhibitors. These numbers must be displayed by the exhibitor when the animal is in the show ring.
- 10. Authority officials have the right to combine any class with 5 or less animals presented.
- 11. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR - "Exhibitor" is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or co-ownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor." An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on six animals or less. In the event of tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes excluding champion classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc. The same point system as Premier Breeder will be used in all Breeds, unless otherwise stated under individual breed.
