### Entry Fee

- \$5.00 per item

### Age Groups

- Junior. 13 years of age and younger
- Youth. 14-18 years of age
- Open. 19 years of age and older
- Senior. 65 years of age and older

## Entry Requirements

These requirements are in addition to the 2024 Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements, the General Entry/Fine Arts 2024 Competition & Entry Requirements, and the Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct

- A. Work must be done solely by the exhibitor. No seminar pieces may be entered.
- B. All entries must be of original composition. No exact copies of known studies by old masters or prominent studies may be used.
- C. Pieces must be painted on porcelain clay bodies or glass.
- D. Porcelain includes glazed porcelain (china) and unglazed porcelain (bisque). No other ceramic products will be accepted (e.g., earthenware, ceramic tile, or pottery).
- E. Glass includes satin or opal glass with painting, stained glass with painting, slumped glass with painting, fused glass with painting, or blown glass with painting.
- F. All pieces must be painted with overglaze (china paints) and fired in a kiln above 750 degrees Fahrenheit.
- G. No decals may be used.
- H. Miniatures are defined as small-scale copies of common objects.
- I. Sets (e.g., a tea set) will be considered one entry.
- J. All signatures on china or glass must be covered with tape. The tape will be removed after judging.
- K. Judging Criteria
  - a. Originality
  - b. suitability of materials
  - c. Creativity
  - d. Craftsmanship
  - e. overall effect
