Competition Requirements

1. All entrants must have read and be familiar with the General Competition Requirements, Livestock and Small Animal Competition Requirements, Colorado State Fair Code of Conduct, Animal Welfare Policy, and Livestock Health Requirements. When applicable, all association rules shall apply.
2. All entrants for livestock exhibited in Open, Breed, or Market competitions shall provide a premises identification number (PID) at entry. To obtain a PID, contact the Colorado

3. Bedding: Exhibitors are responsible for their own livestock bedding. Entry into competition at the Colorado State Fair and Industrial Exposition (“State Fair”) does not include bedding.

Exhibitors may pre-order bedding and shavings through the official bedding vendor or bedding will be available to purchase on-grounds from said vendor upon arrival. The phone number and order portal will be posted on the Fair’s website.

Straw may only be used for dairy cattle, dairy goats, breeding sheep, and open breeding cattle tie-outs. All other uses of straw are prohibited.

Outside bedding for livestock exhibitors is permitted.

4. The original registration papers must be available for inspection at the show. The owner is responsible for entering the animal in the correct class.
5. The Mountains and Plains Texas Longhorn Association (MPTLA) offers 25% of the total premiums, and the Authority will pay 75%.
6. The Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA), P. O. Box 4430, Ft. Worth, TX 76164, and MPTLA, Lana Pearson, Treasurer, P.O. Box 185, Fowler, CO 81039, approves this show and classes.
7. To be eligible to show, all animals must be 120 days of age or older on the show date and be registered with the TLBAA. Any animal with a pending registration at the time of entry application must present a photocopy, facsimile, or original registration certificate on arrival at the show. Registration papers of all animals will be inspected and compared with the animal at the show. Such animals must be entered and shown under the name of the recorded owner; no crossbreeds are eligible.
8. The owner of cattle entered and shown in this show must be a member in good standing of the TLBAA. Exhibitors in the halter section must wear a standard exhibitor number belt clip on the left side. Exhibitor numbers are provided.

9. All bulls shown in the halter division must be shown with a nose lead. See official TLBAA handbook for shown bulls.
10. No animal shall be eligible to compete in more than one class within the same age group; i.e., halter entries are ineligible for loose classes and vice versa.
11. Animals presented to the judge are to be washed, brushed, and combed. Specifically prohibited is sanding and polishing of horns or polishing of hooves. Non-coloration fly sprays are permitted. Trimming of excess hair is permitted.
12. The alteration of physical features and appearance of any animal by cosmetic or surgical means, including but not limited to the weighting of horns, is deemed unethical practices and will be grounds for disqualification. See Livestock and Small Animal Competition Requirements for unethical practices.
13. All females 30 months of age or older must have her nursing calf (205 days old or less) at side or be pregnancy tested safe in calf and indicated on the health certificate. All nursing calves shown with dams must be eligible for registration, no crossbreed calves. Calves with dams shown in the halter division must be halter-broken and shown at halter.
14. Authority officials reserve the right to disqualify and remove any animal from competition deemed unmanageable, and entry fees shall be forfeited.
15. Entry Numbers: Each entry will be assigned a number, which will be provided to all exhibitors. The exhibitor must display these numbers when the animal is in the show ring.
16. Any protest must be presented in writing as stated in the General Competition Requirements.
17. Cattle will be received through Livestock Gate #4 (off Mesa Ave) and will be housed in the Livestock Barn pens and tie-rails. Holding pens are reserved for pen entries only.
18. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this show or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.

Premier Exhibitor

“Exhibitor” is defined as the owner or owners of an animal recorded on the registration paper. Each different recorded ownership (or co-ownership) constitutes a different "Exhibitor". An award will be given to the exhibitor accumulating the most points. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the exhibitor (1) earning points in the greatest number of classes, (2) winning the most first places and (3) winning the most second places, etc. The same point system as Premier Breeder will be used in all Breeds, unless otherwise stated under individual breed.

1st place - 5 points

2nd place - 4 points

3rd place - 3 points

Res. Champion - 6 points

4th place - 2 points

Grand Champion - 10 points

5th place - 1 point

Res. Grand Champion - 8 point

Champion - 7 points
