Entry Requirements

These requirements are in addition to the 2026 Colorado State Fair General Competition Requirements, the General Entry/Fine Arts 2026 Competition & Entry Requirements, and the Colorado State Fair Exhibitor Code of Conduct.

1. Enter online at reggiebeer.com.
2. Up to 4 entries per person.
3. One entry consists of three bottles or cans, two for judging, and one in case of a flaw or breakage.
4. Each bottle or can must have an identification label that you print from reggiebeer.com.
5. Attach labels to bottles or cans with rubber bands.
6. Total entries will be capped at 100

Classes

Classes are judged per the 2021 BJCP Style Guidelines. Your beer will be judged by the category you enter.

Judging

1. Qualified judges will conduct the judging.
2. Any placement in or removal from a category will be at the discretion of the judging chairperson.
3. If the judges are faced with a clearly flawed bottle or can of beer, no more than one additional bottle of the same entry will be opened and tasted.
4. To achieve valid results, the judges will have an appeal process per BJCP sanctioning.
5. The Colorado State Fair Authority and judges may combine classes.

6. Decisions will be based on the merit of the beer. Awards will be awarded at the judges' discretion.
7. Judging is per the AHA and 2021 BJCP guidelines.
8. Stewards and judges may not evaluate a category they have entered.

Beer Drop-off and Shipping

A. Hand-deliver to the fairgrounds

- a. Homebrew will be accepted March 23 to April 10, 2026, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m.- 4 p.m. at the Colorado State Fair Authority's General Entry Office in the Palace of Agriculture.

B. Ship

- a. Pack your bottles or cans carefully!
- b. Include your entry form in the box. Use a rubber band to attach the Bottle ID Form to each bottle/can shipped.
- c. When shipping alcohol, you must comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations that govern alcohol shipment, whether intrastate or interstate. The state of Colorado, the Authority, and the Board are not responsible for lost, stolen, misdirected, or seized shipments of alcohol. Please check with your shipping company for policies about shipping alcohol.
- d. Beer must be received **by 4 p.m. on** April 10th. Ship to: Colorado State Fair Authority Homebrew Competition, Attn: General Entry, 1001 Beulah Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81004

C. Alternate drop-off locations

- a. Drop-off locations will accept homebrew entries from March 23 to April 10, 2026.
- b. Drop-off locations will not issue receipts for your entries or be held liable for your entries.
